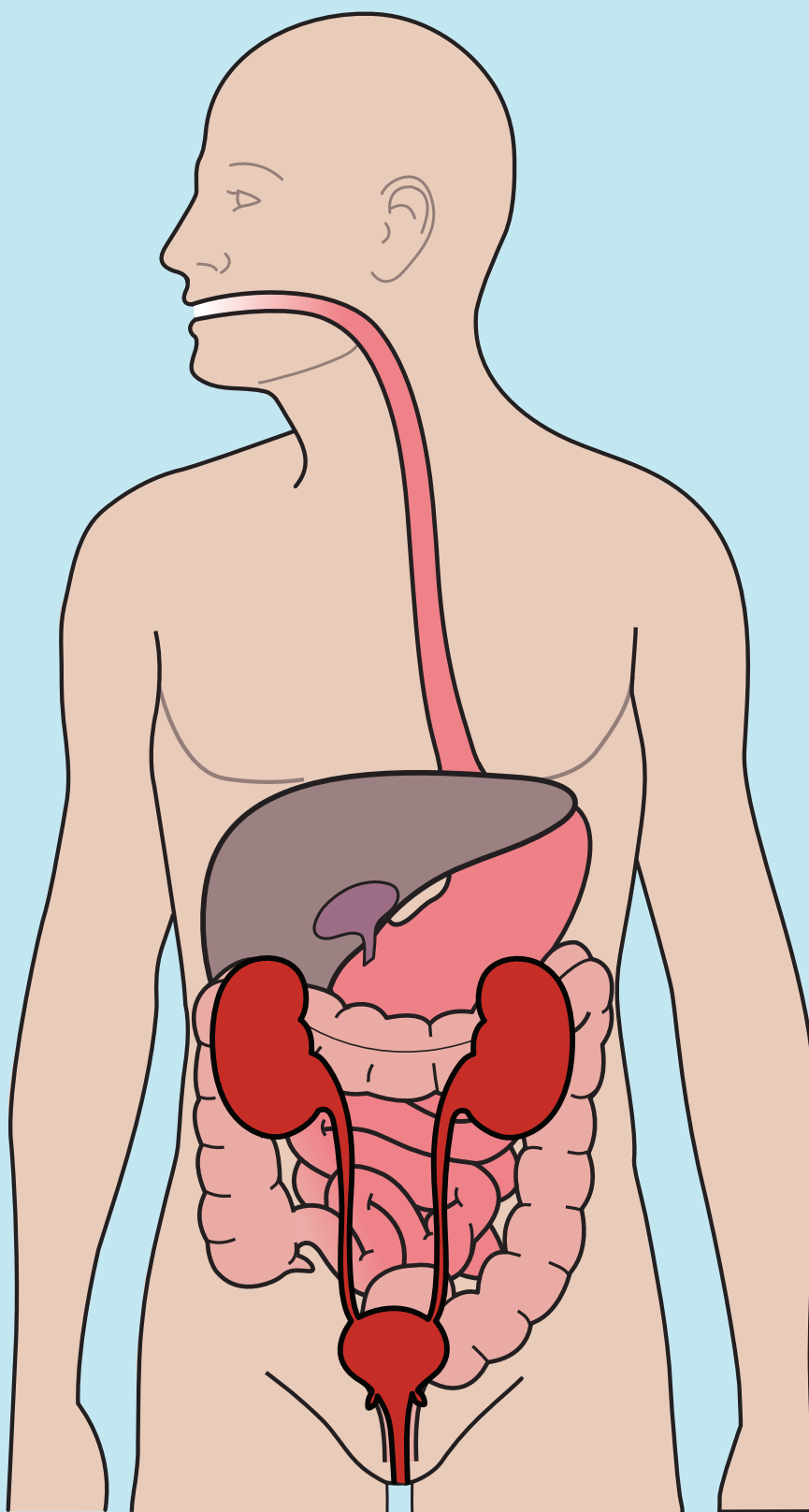

Understanding the basic of the surgical procedure having an ostomy is key in dealing with new circumstances of life. These Surgical Information pads:

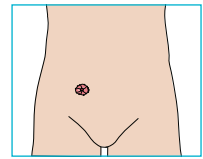
- Simplifies the process of explaining the surgery to people undergoing ostomy surgery.

Simply tear a sheet of the relevant surgery procedure and add individual details to the pre-printed illustrations when preparing or explaining to a person undergoing ostomy surgery.

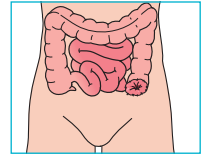

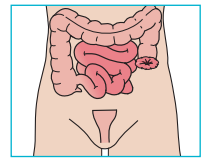
Stoma formation



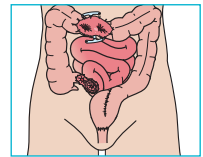
Abdomino-perineal excision of rectum



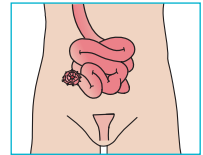
Hartmann's procedure



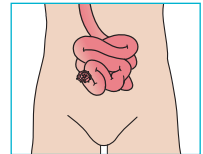
Low anterior resection



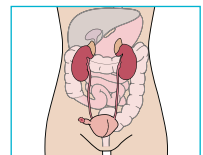
Total colectomy



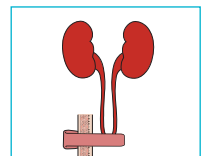
Pan-proctocolectomy



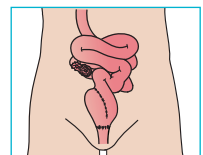
Indiana pouch



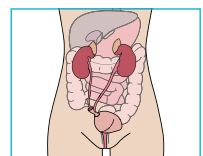
Ileal conduit
